I. BASIC SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF AND OVERHEAD:

This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.) This fee includes the following:

Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial call

Arrangement Conference

Coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased

Clerical assistance in the completion of various forms and permits associated with a funeral

Also covers overhead, including facility maintenance, equipment and inventory costs, insurance and administration expenses, and governmental compliance

II. PREPARATION OF THE BODY:

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

(excluding shipping charges and shipping container). This charge does not include visitation or ceremonies. This charge applies to shipment within the continental U.S. only.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are alternative containers and other cremation containers, including containers made of wood, containers made of fiberboard, and containers made of other composite materials. We also offer a selection of cremation oriented caskets.

Our charges for direct cremation (without ceremony) include removal of remains, transportation to crematory, refrigeration and basic services of staff. Archive fee and crematory fee are also included. (Does not include alternative container or cremation casket. State or County fees not included)

(Not all requests are possible.)
